If you are one of those few individuals who still have not logged on to www.codesp.com, you are missing valuable information. Log-on today and take a look around the site. If you need help, pages 2-4 contain information about using the website. Not only is the CATS Test Item Bank and Test Generator on this site, there are also many valuable Resources and Links to assist you in the recruitment, selection, and retention of classified employees.

Once you have logged in (if you do not have a log-in name and password, or do not know who your district's CATS Administrator is, contact us), you can access the complete site.

By clicking on [Links](#) you will be able to access websites relating to the following topics: HR Associations, ADA, Compensation, HR Consultants, Employee Associations, Government Agencies, Job Analysis, Job Descriptions, NCLB, Test Development, Test Preparation, Surveys, Test Taking Practice, and miscellaneous HR related sites.

The [Resources](#) area of the site contains: Interviews (and Guides, etc.), Interviews by Competency, Supplemental Application Forms (T & Es), Writing Samples, Performance Tests, Pre-Assembled Tests, Tutorials (CATS, Instructional Aide, and General Test-Taking), Test Preparation Materials, Human Resource Guides (NCLB, Exam Planning, Job Analysis, etc.) and much, much more. CODESP offers its members over 200 sample interviews for a variety of specialized subjects listed by job family. They, and the other test materials available under Resources can be modified to meet your district's needs per the Instructions. Customized interviews can be ordered by completing a [CATS Request Form](#) if members can't find the questions they need on our website.

CODESP offers [Pre-Assembled Tests](#) for many of the most common public school employee classifications. They are also available to members under Resources. Pre-Assembled tests are available for Instructional Aide, Food Service Worker, Food Service Cashier, Custodian (entry level), Custodian (experienced), Clerk, and Secretary. Spanish translation tests to determine bilingual skills are also available.

Requesting multiple-choice test items is easy on CATS. Click on and complete the CATS Request Form, attach the job description and hit submit. Within days your job-related test items will appear on your CATS site. Review the items with your SME, click on the ones you want to include on the test, and build and print the test directly from your workstation. **It is that easy!!!!**

Logging On

You must be a CATS User to log on at www.codesp.com to view secure areas. A log-in name and password can be issued by your district's CATS Administrator ([member_admin](#) under [Security Role](#)). If you do not have one, contact us at tests@codesp.com or by calling (714) 374-8644.

Add/Editing User Information

If you are the CATS Administrator ([member_admin](#)), click on the [Add/Edit Profile](#) and then on the memo icon in the right column to make changes and then hit [Update Profile](#). To [Add New User](#) click on the icon on the bottom of the page, complete the information and make their status Active, and then hit [Add Profile](#).





To request Multiple Choice Test Items or Custom Test Materials, log-on and complete the **CATS Request Form**. **Finished** requests are sent to your CATS site under **My Request Status** usually within one week of submission. Click on the **hyperlink** to open your test packet.

Remember Interviews, Supplemental Applications, Pre-Assembled Tests, etc., are located under Resources. They do **NOT** need to be ordered.

Although we can usually respond to your requests within a few days many CATS Requests are being submitted without allowing CODESP staff sufficient time to research or write new test items when necessary. Please, notify us as soon as you know there is an opening, or even when you anticipate openings. Also provide us with:

- adequate time to research/write/edit test items.
- job descriptions that are up-to-date or summaries of the minimum requirements.
- correct email addresses and systems that do not spam block our email.
- requests for types of test materials that are best suited for the position. *For example, management positions do not require the use of a multiple choice test, and positions such as IT which require up-to-date technical knowledge would be best evaluated by a supplemental application form/situational interview and/or performance test.*
- the source of any new multiple choice test items submitted for your test.

Using Other User's Log-In Names and Passwords

If you use other people's CATS User Names and Passwords when you complete a **CATS Request Form** you will **NOT** receive the test materials, they will. At the bottom of the Request Form you will see the box below. **Make sure you choose the correct name from the drop-down box** under **Contact Information**. This will determine which individual's CATS site will receive the test materials. If you are not listed, you need to get your own CATS User Name and Password.
